## **Crusader Contemplations**

"And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God..." Ephesians 6:17

Faith Family,

Last Sunday in Mr. Yurk's children's sermon at Faith Lutheran Church he spoke to the children (and the adults) about the Armor of God from Ephesians chapter six. As He spoke about how God has given us all we need to defend ourselves from the schemes of the Devil, I got to thinking about the verses, especially verse 17 and the sword of the Spirit.

I grew up in Nebraska, where football and volleyball rule. I played flag football for my Lutheran school through 8<sup>th</sup> grade, high school football, and then played college football at two different universities. After moving back to Nebraska while teaching I began coaching football at Lincoln Lutheran High School. I played and coached in a lot of rivalry games, but this game against Lincoln Christian was different. It was centered on faith and the trophy was a sword, the Sword of the Spirit.

The game brought intensity in practice for a week. It brought more focus and added anticipation. We worked harder that week because of the prize at the end. We all wanted to win the Spirit Sword Game and bring the Sword back to our school.

This is what got me in church. We fight so hard and give all our attention, focus, and energy for these moments in sports and in life, but do we miss the big picture? We live and die on the little things, but look back at the verse and see what the Sword of the Spirit is, "the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God."

What if our focus wasn't on the sword, but what it truly was? Can you imagine if our attention and energy was focused on reading, studying, and sharing the Word of God? What a difference for us and for our world we could make if we truly followed the first commandment of our Lord and put Christ and His Word first.

As Mr. Yurk proclaimed on Sunday, we have a loving God who went to the cross to win the war for us, but also cared so much to give us everything we need each day to defend ourselves from sin, death, and the Devil. He gave us armor, but also a sword, the Word of God, to protect us and cut down the temptations that attack us.

Through the work of amazing Christian coaches, the game also became joint tailgates, the Fellowship of Christian Athletes used the postgame as a speaking event, and it had guests who shared our faith in Christ Jesus such as the legendary Tom Osborne (three time national title coach of the Nebraska Cornhuskers). It became a tool and vessel for sharing the Word of God with the world around us as Christians came together to celebrate their faith and encourage one another.

So what is our vessel? Is it sports, music, literature, or math? I am not sure what it is for you, but I do know that God provides daily opportunities in front of all of us through our earthly lives and endeavors to share His love and His saving story. That is why I am here and why the teachers of Faith Lutheran School are here, to take our vocations and use them to joyfully tell others about Jesus.

So together as the Faith Family of Faith Lutheran Church & School let us focus on the things God has provided to us through the lens of the sword of Spirit and share our Lord's Good News with those around us for the encouragement of each other and the growth of God's Kingdom.
